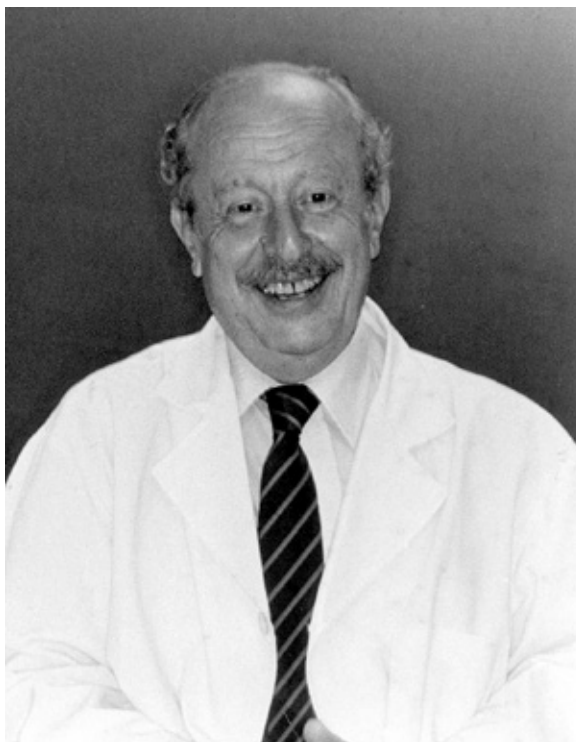


A brief tribute to Dr. Carlos A. Gianantonio 25 years after his death
